

**SELECTBOARD MEETING
RICHFORD, VERMONT**

November 16, 2015

Chair Linda Collins called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 PM with members Tim Green, Wayne Hurtubise and Chris Martel present. Also present were Laura Ovitt, Eric Collins and Joey Randall.

Motion made by Tim Green, seconded by Wayne Hurtubise, to approve the minutes of the Nov. 2 regular meeting. The motion carried.

Motion made by Chris Martel, seconded by Linda Collins, to execute the amendment to the Rail Trail grant that extends the project through 2020. The motion carried.

Linda Collins presented a stipulation prepared by Attorney Michael Gawne regarding Jacobs Logging, LLC.

Laura reported REAC is applying for a Buildings and General Services grant for phase II work on the 111-113 Main Street project, and is requesting a letter of support from the board. The board so agreed.

Wayne Hurtubise reported he and John Nutting have looked into whether a storm drain should be installed at the corner of So. Main and Maple Streets and have determined there is no need. The highway department has worked on the town portion of the drainage ditch at the property. Wayne reported two part-time plow drivers have been hired by the highway department. The board discussed the stump dump and Wayne reported the highway department will not be using the facility. The subject will be discussed further at the next meeting. The highway department is getting ready for winter.

Chris Martel reported the doors are off of the high school's storage building at the playground. The school has been notified.

Larry Patterson is making repairs to the bathroom door.

Chris Martel reported the masonic building sign is in disrepair and the owners have been notified. They have said they hired repairmen to remove the sign.

The board discussed the "Welcome to Richford" signs. Tim Green reported the Lions Club has talk with Premier signs and has authorized \$1000 toward replacing the signs. The club will be working to raise the remainder of the money.

Chris reported a breaking and entering has been reported on River Street.

Chris reported a dog on Guilmette road was hit by a trash truck on Nov. 10. Two residents transported the dog to the vet, where it was later put down.

Laura reported on behalf of Norris Tillotson that the siding project at both pump stations has been completed.

Glen Embury is preparing a quote for planking for the bridge going to the water intake.

One load of sludge has been shipped.
